ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED UNDER THE PROJECT

Activity 1

2-Day National Webinar titled "Understanding Tribal Religion and Culture: With Special Reference to Jharkhand", on 3rd and 4th June 2020 was organised by Amity University, Jharkhand



(AUJ) in Collaboration with Nirmala College, Ranch University (RU). Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic the webinar was conducted on the online platform of Cisco Webex in which participants from different parts of the country joined the deliberations. The number of participants who were given



certificates on the basis of their participation and attendance was 126. The objective of the webinar was to generate serious debate on tribal life and culture which includes both folk and popular culture, their creation myth, their understanding of religion, their connection with the ecology and environment and their cultural movements. On 3rd June 2020 two resource persons gave their talk namely, Prof. (Dr.) Padmaja Sen, Former Head and Professor, Department of Philosophy, Kolhan University Chaibasa and Dr. Radhika Borde, Senior Researcher, Department of Social Geography and Regional Development, Charle's University, Prague gave their talk. On 4th June 2020 Prof. (Dr.) Ramesh K. Sharan, Former Vice Chancellor, Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh and Dr. Santosh K. Kiro, Asst. Prof., Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, St. Xavier's College, Ranchi carried discussions with the participants.

Activity 2

A Seven Day Online Workshop for Research Scholars, Topic: "Tribal Research Methodology", 21st to 27th August 2020 by Nirmala College, Ranchi University in Collaboration with AUJ. The



activity was conducted on the online platform of Zoom, and it selected 50 participants for an assignment-based Workshop. The programme was designed to ensure that the participants learned the modern tools and techniques of Research in Tribal studies and their assignments were given and corrected the next day to hone their learning skills. On the basis of the submission of their assignment 31 participants were awarded certificates and 3 awards were given for Best participants.





Activity 3
